

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CARLOW/MAYO

BY-LAW NUMBER 46-2007

BEING A BY-LAW TO SET AN ACCOUNTABILITY

AND TRANSPARENCY POLICY

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended by Bill 130, Section 270 (1) states “A municipality shall adopt and maintain policies with respect to the following matter.”

5. The manner in which the municipality will try to ensure that it is accountable to the public for its actions, and the manner in which the municipality will try to ensure that its actions are transparent to the public.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Carlow/Mayo deems it expedient to adopt and maintain a policy to provide guidance for the delivery of the municipality’s activities and services in accordance with the Act.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Carlow/Mayo acknowledges that it is responsible to provide good government for its stakeholders in an accountable and transparent manner by:

- Encouraging public access and participation to ensure that decision making is responsive to the needs of its constituents and receptive to their opinions;
- Delivering high quality services to our citizens; and
- Promoting the efficient use of public resources.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Carlow/Mayo ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** Council does hereby adopt the attached Policy with respect to Accountability and Transparency as set out in Schedule “A” and forming part of this by-law.
2. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon its final passing.
3. **AND THAT** this by-law repeals any and all previous by-laws and/or motions pertaining to same.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 4TH DAY OF DECEMBER 2007.
