Laura read the minutes of the last meeting held on Tuesday, May 31, 2011.

Amendments to the minutes are as follows:

- with regard to the Community Centre being totally self-sustaining: this is not so. The Recreation Committee and the Seniors Group pay only hydro, heat and some maintenance. The Township also provides some maintenance, insurance and snow removal. A report is being prepared by Lois Ward, which will give the breakdown for the above.

- with respect to the contract between the Mayo Community Centre, the Recreation Committee and the Little Mississippi Senior Citizens Club, a new contract has not been prepared, but is in the works.

Moved by Bonnie and seconded by Jim that the minutes be accepted as amended. All in favour. Motion carried.

Joy read the Treasurer's Report. Moved by Scott and seconded by Karla that the Treasurer's Report be accepted as read. All in favour. Motion carried.

### **First Aid Kit**

We are still without a first aid kit. Karla will make enquiries with the Township Council and ensure that one or two of them will be installed as soon as possible.

### **Concession Booth**

Brenda will prepare a notice with a list of regulations to be followed for those using the concession booth. Laura will type and laminate this list and post it in the concession booth.

### **Garbage**

There was a misunderstanding following the Black Bear Rally which resulted in garbage not being removed. This has been reviewed and should not happen again. Bonnie volunteered to set up a system for recycling outside of the hall.

### **Fundraisers**

Both the Black Bear Rally and the Volleyball tournament were successful fund raisers. There was a quantity of bottled water and pop left over from the Volleyball tournament. We talked about selling it off to our members, but it was still left at the hall. Laura had to call committee members about another issue, so took a vote on whether we should donate it to the Fort Stewart Gemboree for their fundraiser. The telephone vote was that we should go ahead with this plan.

We discussed having a Spaghetti Dinner/dance fundraiser to be held on Saturday, October 1, 2011. A planning meeting will be held on Thursday, September 1, 2011 at 2:00 pm, to strike a committee for same. Karla will obtain a bar licence for this event. It was suggested that we have John Hales make a CD of mixed music for us. Another idea was for Tony Hastrop to provide music with his sound equipment for this occasion. Laura suggested that we use the proceeds from this dance towards a sound system for the hall. Jim will get some 'professional' quotes.

A survey was taken by telephone as to whether to sell tickets to the spaghetti dinner and dance, at the door or in advance. The result was that we advertise the event and sell tickets at the door.

### **Repairs and Maintenance**

In addition to several members of our committee, Clayton Thompson and Horace Adams have been very helpful with minor repairs and cleanup. Many thanks to all for their assistance here.

### **Break In**

It appears that there has been a break in at the hall. There was damage to some doors and \$12.00 from the euchre proceeds was taken from a locked cupboard. Repairs were done by Clayton Thompson, and no monies will be left in the hall in future.

Moved by Bonnie and seconded by Scott that the meeting be adjourned. All in favour. Motion carried.
